

Case Study Decontamination at a Medical Center

Decontamination

As the COVID-19 crisis appeared to subside, a medical center in Seattle's historic Central District asked ATI to decontaminate specially isolated care rooms no longer needed for coronavirus patients.

ATI, which has had an Emergency Response Agreement with the medical center since performing terminal cleaning in 2019, had the expertise required for the job. Its team is trained in COVID-19 issues and HIPAA compliance; certified in asbestos work and the use of personal protective equipment; and current with flu shots and other vaccinations.

The project included establishing a preparation area, fogging the rooms and wiping all hard surfaces with Centers for Disease Control-approved disinfectants. Workers vacuumed and mopped vinyl and tile flooring; removed negative air machines and other equipment; and properly disposed hazardous waste.

The five rooms were completed in two days, allowing the health care facility to repurpose them to better serve the community's needs. It was ATI's first COVID-19 decontamination project after it had installed negative pressure isolation areas for many hospitals earlier in the pandemic.
